THE NATURAL

Don't pass up the barrel-fermented beers (or the pizzas from the wood-burning oven) at Bozeman, Montana's newest gem, **Mountains Walking Brewery & Pub**. The 20-tap tasting room serves brewer Gustav Dose's hyperlocal beers, some of which are made with Bozeman-native wild yeasts. The brews are naturally lower in alcohol and sugar, so drink up. mountainwalking.com.

THROUGH THE GRAPEVINE

Keep your eyes peeled in Napa, where **Stone Brewing** will soon open a taproom in the long-vacant Borreo

Building. Expect a full kitchen and an outdoor patio overlooking the Napa River, which makes the perfect spot to sip an IPA or a special release from the on-site 10-barrel brewing system. stonebrewing.com.

On October 14, **Squatters** is planning on breaking records, serving up more than 1,086 gulps of beer off a blocklong ski in downtown Park City.
